A-C started slow and struggled as Coudersport built a good lead over the Falcons in set one. Down 19-24; A-C pulled together and scored 7 straight points to come from behind to claim set 1 by the score of 26-24. Set 2 mirrored the first set as A-C fell behind by the score of 12-5. Determined, the Falcons fought back and pulled ahead 26-25; but could not close out the set. Coudersport scored 3 quick points to take set 2 by the score of 28-26. The fans saw many long rallies as A-C built a lead and won set 3 by the score of 25-21. Set 4 saw the home Falcons slowly pull ahead and with good serving and great defense; A-C closed out the match with a 25-18 victory. With this 3-1 win; the Falcons move on to play in the championship match on Saturday against Otto Eldred. The match will be at St. Mary's High School at 11:00 AM. The Falcons have also qualified to play in the PIAA State play-offs next Tuesday.
