The varsity followed with a 3 set sweep by the scores of 25-19, 25-14 and 25-9. Leading the way was Emily with 25 service points, 6 aces and 20 assists. The Falcon attack was led by Kylee with 17 kills, Olivia with 11 kills and Meah I. with 4 kills. The varsity record also stands at 13 wins and 2 losses. The Falcons will host Oil City Monday night as they celebrate senior night.
