- 42%, about 1,730 people, living in Clarion are living in poverty.
- 1.55 million PA residents lived in poverty in 2017, which is 12.5% of the PA population.
- 17% of PA children lived in poverty in 2017. PA ranks 26th in child poverty rate.
- 20.8% of people in PA who have a disability lived in poverty in 2017.
- One in four African Americans and an even higher proportion of Latinos live in poverty in PA – about triple the rate of non-Hispanic whites.
