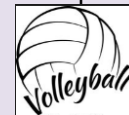

The Falcons remain unbeaten with an 11-0 record in the KSAC and 15-0 record overall. Sydney led the way from the service line with 20 points, 4 aces; Josey followed with 8 points. Defensively, Olivia had 18 digs, Josey 14, Syd 13 and Cassie 11. Kylee took away their attack with 5 blocks. Setting up the offense was Sydney with 18 assists, Emily with 8 and Kaylie with 7. Leading the attack was Josey with 10 kills, Kylee and Olivia 8 each; Cassie with 7. A-C travels to the ECC Tournament Saturday and to Slippery Rock Monday night for final preparations for the playoffs. Congratulations for claiming the second KSAC Championship in the past 3 years.
