The Chase A. Longo Memorial Scholarship Fund was established to assist students attending Allegheny-Clarion Valley School District who:

- Will graduate with their class each May/June;
- Have been accepted into a four-year accredited college or university;
- Enrolled as a full-time student;
- Intend to pursue a minimum of a four-year degree;

Applicants are required to illustrate the following:

Character: Demonstrated leadership and/or involvement in their respective or adjoining communities through volunteerism, service, community projects, etc.

Honor: Provide two Letters of Recommendation from a non-family member who knows you well enough to speak about your overall character with emphasis on your ability to fulfill obligations.

Academic Excellence: Minimum 3.5 G.P.A. (at the time of application) and overall commitment to high academic standards.

School Pride & Involvement: Active, successful participation in at least one sport combined with active, successful participation in at least two school clubs or activities (*Do Something Good Club, Music, Key Club, Choir, Band, etc.*). Applicants must illustrate a diverse combination of School Involvement in these activities.

Essay: Submit a 750 word essay on the following Essay Question

Why is it important to be involved in school and community related activities? How has your involvement in both contributed to who you are as an individual, a student, and/or a leader?
